YOUR TREASURER'S RANT

Sympathy goes out to the family. of Ralph Plaisted. Mr. Plaisted passed away at his Wyoming, MN home on September 8th. He was 80 years old.



Back in 1968 I remember the excitement of watching a CBS News Documentary by Charles Kuralt about the Ralph Plaisted expedition. An insurance man turned adventurer, Mr. Plaisted with three companions, Walt Pederson, Gerry Pitzl, and Jean-Luc



Bombardier, accompanied by Mr. Kuralt, piloted their Ski-Doo snowmobil\es from Ward Hunt Island, Canada for over 400 miles to the North Pole. His achievement is the first confirmed excursion to the North Pole. Although



the Robert Perry and Frederick Cook expeditions claim to have reached

the pole in 1909, historical records do not confirm the pole was reached. Perry was off by 121 miles according to a 1988 review of his logs. A US Air Force flyover confirmed the Plaisted expedition's arrival at the pole on April 19, 1968, 43 days after departure. The aircraft also gave them a ride home.

I will remember him as a culmination of the adventurous spirit

of every snowmobile enthusiast!
